

The Shand store in 1980. Built in the 1850's, this is one of the oldest commercial buildings in Patchogue. The original owner of the store was John S. Havens.



Shand's general merchandise storestore, on the northeast corner of Havens Avenue and Main Street. The store, which was owned by the Shand family since 1914, was sold in 1990. This picture was taken in 1989.



In 1995 the former Shand store became the Brick House Brewery and Restaurant. The wooden front extension of the store was removed and replaced with a brick extension, housing the brewery equipment, which blends in nicely with the brick of the main building. Great care has been taken to preserve as many of the original features of the building as possible.
