

A beautiful Jim Mooney aerial picture of the Patchague River, taken September 4, 1957. The street in the foreground is Division Street. The building with the smokestack below Division Street is the PELCO power plant. In the left lower part of the picture remnants of the former Bailey Lumber Mill are visible. The street on the right side is River Avenue. The Patchague River at this time was an important harbor for oil deliveries to the south shore of Long Island. Three tank farms are visible in this picture.
