Reverend Monsignor James J. Cronin, became the pastor of the St. Francis de Sales Church July 3, 1897. His many friends included the Reverend Johnston of the Congregational Church and the Episcopal minister, Reverend Harrington. 1938 marked the golden anniversary of father Cronin's ordination. When he died in June of 1946, the village and town hall flags were flown at half-mast in tribute to a great man.
