

Louise Staudinger started in business in 1935 in Greenport, opening a knitting shop. In 1946, she moved to Patchogue, opening a store east of the theater with a partner. She opened her own shop on the north side of West Main Street in 1955, and moved to the well known location of her Colony Shop on the south side of the street in 1962.
