

Lou & Mack's restaurant was owned by the Dorr brothers. William and Hermann. The restaurant was to the east of Gutte's on West Main Street in this 1942 picture. Gutte's at this time was a grocery store, established in 1931. Nick's Shoe Repair was the next building to the east, followed by the Liberty Restaurant and Swozey's. The reason for the concerned look on the soldiers face is because of "Duke", the Patchogue mascot, who is just visible behind the car.
