



A 1970 picture of South Ocean Avenue and the Rialto Theater. The Rialto was originally the Unique Theater but was re-named the Rialto when Mike Glynne bought the theater in the early 1920's. The theater became a total loss due to a fire December 5, 1925, but was rebuilt and enlarged and re-opened May 28, 1926. A second fire, February 16, 1978, destroyed the theater again and it was never rebuilt.
