

The first offices of the Village of Patchogue were in the Wedgewood building on West Main Street. In the 1930's the former Henry Baker home, on the south side of Baker Street, was converted into the headquarters for the village government. This building was located next to the TERA building,

which in 1935 became the new Village Hall. The former Baker home became the YMCA building, which in later years was torn down and the site became the parking lot for the Patchogue Village Hall.
