

This is the Hammond and Mills Department Store on the southeast corner of Main Street and Ocean Avenue in 1910. Originally, the general store of William and J.E. Roe, which duted back to the first quarter of the century, stood on this site. The first part of the Hammond and Mills store, which is the gabled corner section, was built in 1876. Later, a fourth story was added. The four-story south and east wings were added in the 1890's Small businesses, offices and apartments occupied the upper floors.
