Brummel's Confectionery and Cigar Store was located on South Ocean Avenue, opposite Academy Street. Mr. Brummel himself is posing for the camera. This is the same store as the above picture, only about twenty years later.



The 1898 home of the Argus, a Patchogue newspaper, was located on the east side of South Ocean Avenue, about halfway between Terry and Main Street. The Argus newspaper was first printed in 1884, The editor of the Argus was L.B. Green.. On October 8, 1930, the Patchogue Advance bought out the Argus.
