We crossed the Atlantic under our own power in 110 ft. chasers stopping at Bermuda, Azores, Brest, arriving Plymouth, England in June.

Patrolled English Channel until Aug 20 and was then transferred to Looe, Ireland, patrolling Irish Sea & south coast until Armistice. Made contact with two submarines, the British Admiralty giving us credit for sinking one and damaging the other. At the time of armistice were operating out of Holyhead, Wales. Later we were sent to Le Harve, France to do harbor work, then to Brest and still later to Lisbon, Portugal. Returned to the U.S. under own power having logged over 50,000 miles.
