First wounded by shrapnel Patchogue

Private Harvey Hammond of Patchogue, L. I., was wounded in an engagement on June 13. His name has never appeared on the casualty list, but, according to a letter received from him by his folks this week, he was struck in the foot by a piece of shrapnel and was under treatment in a base hospital. Private Hammond went to Camp Upton early last October and was soon transferred to Camp Gordon, Ga. He left for France in April with Company F, 328th Infantry.
