Since my entrance in the military service, I have been stationed at Fort Hamilton, New York, serving as Private 1st Class in the Quartermaster Corps, up to and including September 10, 1918, on which date I was appointed Army Field Clerk, and have served in that capacity to date. I have served at no other place than Fort Hamilton, N.Y., during my military service. This includes in detail my service in the army since December 10, 1917.
