I was at Pelham Bay Camp for 7 months. Then made 10 trips to the Norfolk, Va., as a cadet in the Naval Auxiliary <sup>Officers</sup> School. After that I was sent back to the N.A.R. school at Pelham. After graduating from there, Ensign (D), was sent to the N.A.R. headquarters, South and Whitehall Sts. N.Y.C.
