Infantry and went to Eagle Pass, Texas
Sept 1916 -

Served 8 months on the Mexican Bor-
der and May 14th 1917 entrained for
Syracuse N.Y.

Did M.P. duty at Solway Station
July 1st 1917 promoted to Corporal
and transferred to Co. D. - 38th U.S.
Infantry July 1917.

Aug 16th 1917 transferred to Wg Co
16th Infantry and made Serg't Aug
25th 1917.

Sailed for France Nov 1917 and
transferred — to Co. D. - 16th Infantry

Extended trenches etc —
— and participated in the following
Battles and engagements. -

Nov 11, 1918 was in Buzancy Woods again
and Nov 12 was at Camel, from there started
on the long hike for Cobenz Bridgehead

Esch, Itzig, Neusdorf, Grewmacher,
Pallien, Hohren, Wittlich, Hasboun,
Stotsbusch, Cochem, Schuren, Cobbenz,
Ransbach, Derubach and Montabaur.

— Returned to U.S.A. — on the
U.S. Transport Freedom, went to Camp
Merritt, N.J.

Was in the 1st Division Parade in
N.Y. city and Washington D.C. from there
went to Camp Meade, Md, then to
Camp Taylor, Ky and did duty at
Charlestown, N. Va. at the coal strike,
then back to Camp Taylor.
